High School Summer Course Policy

High school summer courses are essential for students who need to earn required credits to meet graduation requirements, particularly those not enrolled in dual credit courses or unable to complete such courses through a dual credit program.

High school summer courses at RSA are managed by RSA teachers with payments made directly to them. RSA provides the students a valuable opportunity to meet the High School Graduation requirement by utilizing the school's curriculum, portal system, and a variety of instructional resources, all facilitated by experienced teachers. This structured approach helps students effectively achieve their academic goals during the summer.

During the regular school year, students might face schedule conflicts that prevent them from enrolling in necessary courses. Summer courses provide an alternative time frame to complete these requirements. Fall and spring semesters can be demanding, and taking courses in the summer helps to balance the overall course load, reducing stress during the school year.

Graduation Requirements: We help students stay on track and reach their goals for graduation. Radiant STEM Academy offers most of the core courses during summer that are required to graduate on time and earn the high school diploma students are pursuing. The summer program offers high school credits and credit recovery options for students needing to retake failed courses, ensuring they can catch up and progress towards graduation.

Dual Credit Limitations: For students unable to participate in dual credit programs, summer courses provide an essential pathway to stay on track for graduation.

Instructor: High school summer courses will be taught by approved RSA instructors who will release the syllabi. ***These classes will be conducted virtually, and instructors will provide online login information.*** Upon enrollment in summer High School Courses, students will receive messages from their teachers. All assignments will be graded by the teachers, and reports will be posted on Renweb/ FACTS SIS. All assignments with reports submitted to FACTS. Teachers will offer guidance, grades, and relevant comments on student work. This setup allows students to complete coursework asynchronously, without needing to be online simultaneously with their instructors.

Attendance: Attendance is mandatory for students who are enrolled in summer courses, and failure to attend will result in students being off-track for high school graduation. Scholars who miss more than 2 class periods of any individual class will forfeit their opportunity to earn or recover that credit. Tardies of more than 10 minutes will count as an absence for that day. If you know that your child will miss a day of class, please communicate with their teacher so that they can complete their work. Credit Recovery is required for scholars who did not earn credit during the school year for courses that are high school graduation requirements.

Number of Summer Courses: Students may take up to four high school credits during the summer program.

Schedule: The schedule will vary based on how many courses students are taking or need to recover. Teacher will send the schedule along with the syllabus once the summer course enrollment is complete.

Course Load Management: Summer courses are online, and teachers assign work to be completed on a weekly basis. Teachers will meet online once a week to introduce new concepts and review progress. Students need to be organized and follow the syllabus requirements. It's recommended that students create their own study schedule to ensure their credit recovery classes do not interfere with other activities.

Recovery courses, specifically designed for students needing to retake classes, are common features. This setup ensures students can fulfill their educational requirements without affecting their regular academic year schedules.
